**THE PRODUCER RESPONSIBILITY OBLIGATIONS (PACKAGING WASTE)  
REGULATIONS (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1999 AND AMENDMENTS.**

**RE: DECISION ON APPLICATION FOR EXPORTER ACCREDITATION**

The Northern Ireland Environment Agency (NIEA) has considered your application and hereby grants accreditation to Greenway (Ireland) Limited as an Exporter of packaging waste for your site at 11 Porthill Road Mountnorris, Armagh County Armagh BT60 2TY subject to the conditions of accreditation set out in Schedule 5 (see attached). Your accreditation will entitle you to issue Packaging Export Recovery Notes (PERNs). You may only issue PERNs for plastic packaging waste.

This accreditation does not replace any other environmental authorisations that you have for the site; you must still comply with these and other relevant legislation.

This accreditation is valid from 11<sup>th</sup> February 2010 to 31<sup>st</sup> December 2010 unless it is cancelled by the NIEA or is deemed to be cancelled under the regulations (Appendix 1). This accreditation only applies to the named company, for the named site. You must notify NIEA immediately in writing of any changes to the details submitted with your application. If the ownership or occupancy of this site changes, you may have to make a new application for accreditation.

As an accredited Exporter you are required to comply with the conditions in Schedule 2A of the regulations and the NIEA conditions specified (Appendix 1).
